Staff report Rachel Wood scored from third base in the eighth inning as Baldwin County edged Spanish Fort 1-0 Tuesday in a game that featured two no-hitters.

Winning pitcher Candice Guy struck out 15 and left runners at first and second in the top of the eighth. Spanish Fort's Morgan Druhan struck out 20 but lost when Wood stole third and raced home on a dropped third strike with two outs.

The Toros host Robertsdale tonight at 6, and Baldwin County plays Fairhope at 4 p.m. Friday in the county tournament at Spanish Fort.

-- THEODORE 2, SATSUMA 1: Emily Evans homered on the first pitch she saw with two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning to give Theodore the win. Kristian Mangham threw a four-hitter for the Bobcats (1-0), who play in the Baker tournament Monday. Courtney Singley took the loss for Satsuma (0-1).

-- BRYANT 5, MARY MONTGOMERY 3: Jill Lambert's solo home run broke a 2-2 tie and ignited a three-run sixth inning for Bryant (1-0). Lambert also had an RBI double for the Hurricanes. HANK AARON CLASSIC -- UMS-WRIGHT 12, MURPHY 3: A four-run fifth inning proved to be the difference in the Bulldogs' win in the Hank Aaron Classic.

Sophomore Robert Alexander, who came on in the third inning in relief of starter Wesley Parrish, got the win, throwing 2 innings of one-hit ball. Evan Grovenstein came on in the sixth and pitched a scoreless two innings.

Rawley White and Nick Laskey provided the big bats for UMS-Wright — White went 3-for-4 with three RBIs, while Laskey went 2-for-3 with two RBIs for the Bulldogs (2-0), who won despite committing six errors.

"We were able to put together some timely hits," said UMS coach Brett Boutwell, whose team meets McGill-Toolen tonight at 6:30 at UMS. "With our number one pitcher out, we had to go to our backup guys. We started a sophomore (Parrish), and since it was his first varsity game, we knew we had to give him some help. He gave us three solid innings, and Alexander came in and got the win for us."

Parker Bayer had a solid start for Murphy (0-2), going three innings and striking out five, but didn't get much support. Christian Harwood had an RBI, and Jarrod Reed went 2-for-3 for the Panthers, who play Davidson at 4 p.m. today at UMS.

"We pulled our starting pitcher (Bayer) because of the pitch count," said Murphy coach Bryan Giles. "He did a great job, but the guys we put in after him couldn't get any outs. In addition, we did not do a good job with men on base."
