### Murphy Panthers scratch out three-hit win over Citronelle

Wildcats pitcher Katlin Rutland held the Panthers to three hits, but Murphy scored two runs in the first inning on a pair of walks, a sacrifice and two passed balls, and got two more in the second on Gaby Aragon's single.
